

How to Nominate

Any 10-year member of the Steel City Softball League, whether living or deceased, can be nominated for the Hall of Fame. The nominees should have made significant contributions to the league and/or LGBTQ+ community as part of the SCSL. Anyone familiar with a candidate, including the candidate, can make nominations for the Hall-once per season, no later than the end of the season. The Board of Directors will vote on the nominees each year, based on the credentials presented with the applications. The candidates who receive at least two-thirds of the votes cast are inducted into the Hall at the annual SCSL awards ceremony.

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Membership Eligibility

Any member of the SCSL, living or deceased, (including players, managers, coaches, scorekeepers, social (nonplayers) and fans), who have been in an association for at least ten years are eligible for nomination to the Hall of Fame. Nominees should have made significant contributions to the-league and/or LGBTQ+ community as part of the SCSL.

Applications for nomination to the SCSL Hall of Fame shall be made at any Board of Directors meeting up to the end of the SCSL season or by August 1. The applications may be submitted by any person, including the candidate's his/herself, who is familiar with the candidate. We strongly recommend that the application include a photograph of the nominee. The reason for the photo is that names do not always convey the person nominated. A picture is worth a thousand words and could jog the memory of the voting members. This could determine whether or not a nominee is elected into the Hall of Fame. The photo will become the property of the SCSL Hall of Fame. No more than four members can be nominated in any year. Nominated people who are not elected can be nominated again in future seasons (years).

Voting Members

Voting members shall consist of the following:

1. The Board of Directors of the SCSL.
